

# **Gospel Observation Worksheet ①: John**

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## **Simply Read through the Book of John**

At this stage you are just taking it all in. You'll read through the book a few times in this study and the first time you want to just soak it all in – you might even skim some parts. As you read or when you finish write down your general impressions and thoughts. Look over the following questions before you start so that you have an idea of what you are looking for. Start by praying and asking the Holy Spirit to teach you and guide you.
